The Autism Society of the RMWB provides continuous support to parents, caregivers, and individuals by offering information, guidance, and connection to services and resources. We assist individuals and families in navigating community and government systems. Through inclusive programming for children, youth, and adults, drop-in opportunities, and transitions-to-adulthood supports, we create spaces for connection, skill development, and participation. We also deliver educational presentations, collaborate with schools and community partners, and take part in community awareness initiatives, helping to strengthen the inclusive and supportive community we are proud to live in.

*Autism is a lifelong neurodevelopmental condition. According to the Public Health Agency of Canada, approximately 1 in 50 Canadian children and youth aged 1–17 have been identified as being on the autism spectrum (PHAC, 2019).*

To recognize **Autism Awareness Day on April 2**, we are inviting you to participate in our **Autism Awareness Sticker and Tattoo Campaign**. Participants may choose to purchase either an **Autism Awareness Sticker** or a **Temporary Tattoo** for **\$1.00 each or by donation**.

### How to participate:

- Schools and businesses are asked to **email us in advance** to let us know the **approximate number of stickers and/or tattoos** they would like to have available.
- Stickers/Tattoos will be delivered **prior** to April 2, 2026.
- We will coordinate pick-up of donations following the event.

**Schools may choose to sell stickers and/or tattoos on April 2, 2026, or on another date during Autism Awareness Month.**
